PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Playing hockey should be fun. This doesn't mean that you shouldn't take it seriously, just that at the same time you should enjoy it.
2. Understanding and playing by the rules is your responsibility. The rules exist for the safety, proper order and enjoyment of all people involved in hockey.
3. Treat all players, umpires and coaches with respect. For respect to be received, respect needs to be given.
4. Be a good sport. Acknowledge all good plays whether they are by your team or the other team. Good manners and respect can be infectious. Be Gracious in both wins and losses.
5. Umpires and officials have a difficult task to perform and you could not play the game without them. They are there to enforce the rules of play but they cannot always be right. Accept bad calls graciously. Abuse of umpires is unacceptable behaviour.
6. Verbal or physical abuse of umpires or other players on or off the field is not acceptable or permitted in hockey.
7. Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person. Regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background, religion or other factor irrelevant to the game, all persons connected with hockey are entitled to equal treatment and respect.
8. Always respect the use of facilities and equipment provided. Do not engage in dangerous practices. Not only can equipment be damaged but serious injury can occur.
